



Children Discipleship Director

Purpose: To steward Clifford's family discipleship through intentional ministry to children birth through fifth grade.

Description: The Children Discipleship Director at Clifford Baptist will be a mature follower of Christ who desires to see children come to faith and parents equipped to disciple their children. This position will be responsible for implementing and casting vision for all children ministries birth through 5th grade. While handling the children's ministries of the church, this individual will also be expected to build relationships with the parents and families of the congregation.

It is imperative that this individual can lead others and delegate tasks. A strong work ethic and ability to effectively multi-task is needed. Furthermore, this individual must be able to work well in a team environment while also being able to work autonomously. Lastly, this individual must be able to foster his or her own spiritual growth in addition to ministerial responsibilities.

Responsibilities: Under the pastoral oversight of the pastors, the following ministries will be under the guidance and care of the Children Discipleship Director:

- Children Sunday School classes
- Worship Hour Children Ministries: Nursery, Pre-School, Shining Lights (Grades K – 1st), & King Jesus Kids (KJK) (Grades 2nd – 5th)
- By coordination with Women's Missionary Union (WMU) Director: Girls in Action (GA) (Grades 1st – 5th) & Mission Friends (2 yo - K).
- Royal Ambassadors (RA) (1st – 5th grade boys), Nursery Committee, Vacation Bible School (VBS), Fall Festival, Easter Egg Hunt, etc
- By coordination with Worship Pastor: Children Choirs

Duties:

- Coordinate with pastors to equip and resource parents to disciple their children
- Coordinate and participate in Sunday morning & Wednesday night children ministries
- Schedule/support volunteers and order curriculum for children's Sunday School classes
- Equip volunteers in coordination with pastors
- Ensure secure check-in & pick up of children
- Visit, teach, sit-in with ministries under purview
- Co-Chair the Child Abuse Prevention (CAP) Committee
- Serve on other committees as necessary
- Attend church meetings as necessary
- Conduct periodic home, hospital, school, and sports visitation
- Other responsibilities as assigned
- Attend regularly scheduled staff meetings as schedule permits

Qualifications:

- Must be faithful in making disciples and growing in Christ
- Must be able to pass a background check.
- Bachelor's degree in religion, ministry, or related field is preferred but not required.
- Media/technical skills are preferred but not required.
- It is preferred that the individual be married

Compensation: This will be a part-time (approx. 10-20 hrs. per week) salaried position.
